In the sky, you can see the sun, stars, and the moon. The sun is up during the day. It is very hot. The sun gives us light and heat. Plants need the sun to grow. We can see the stars at night. They give off light and heat, like the sun. That is because the sun is a star, too! There are more stars than we can count. Some people see shapes in the stars. A group of stars that make a shape is called a constellation. Have you ever seen the Big Dipper? That is a constellation! Many stars and constellations were named in ancient's times for gods and animals that they resembled. The moon is out at night. Sometimes we can still see it during the day! It does not give off light and heat. The sun has been shining for 4.6 billion years and has remained relatively unchanged over time. The core temperature of the sun is 15 million degrees Celsius or 27 million degrees Fahrenheit, hotter than anything found on earth, even the earth's fiery core. Electricity can be generated from the sun's heat.
